Prior information notice of competitive tender for laboratory testing of professional refrigerated storage cabinets and household washing machines

(January/February 2024)

PROSAFE is seeking accredited, independent laboratories located within the EEA with experience of testing professional refrigerated storage cabinets and household washing machines for testing work under the EU project JAHARP2022. An open tender will be launched on 29 January with a deadline of 23 February, for appliance testing to be carried out between April 2024 and November 2024. Laboratories may bid for either or both product groups.

Laboratories are invited to register their interest in the tender, without obligation. Scope of required testing services:

- Professional refrigerated storage cabinets EN16825:2016/A1:2019 or EN ISO 22041:2019/A1:2019 under Regulations 2015/1094 and 2015/1095;
- Household washing machines to EN 60456:2016+A11:2021, EN 60704-2-4:2012+A11:2020 (relating to noise testing), CLC/TS 50677:2022, CLC/TS 50707:2020 under Regulations 2019/2014, 2021/340 and 2019/2023.

About JAHARP2022-01:

The Joint Market Surveillance Action on HARmonised Products 2022 (JAHARP2022) is a group of five of European Union (EU) co-funded projects coordinated by PROSAFE.

In total, 10 Market Surveillance Authorities (MSAs) from the 10 following countries participate: Belgium, Croatia, Finland, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Portugal, Romania, and Spain. The objectives of JAHARP2022 are:

- 1. To keep non-compliant and/or dangerous products outside of the Single Market.
- 2. To support the application of the new Market Surveillance Regulation (EU) 2019/1020.
